16,000 Qatari Tourists Flow to Turkey in Two Months

Doha - Apr 28, 2018: Most recent figures from the [Republic of Turkey Ministry of Culture and Tourism](http://www.tcfnewswire.net/en/company/turkey-tourism) revealed a growth of 9.160% in the number of Qatari tourists arriving in Turkey during the months of January and February compared to the same period last year, reaching 75.15 thousand Qatari tourists.

Thus, Qatar Tourism market registered the highest growth rate at GCC level in Turkey, and is ranked second largest market after Kuwait which registered over 29 thousand travelers landing in the Turkey during the same period. The number of Qataris visited Turkey during the last year was 76.48 thousand tourists compared to 68.32 thousand tourists in 2016, a growth rate of 2.49%.
